
Report the Injury

Report the injury to your employer.



File a Claim Form

File a Claim Form with the NYS Workers' Compensation Board.




The Claim is Accepted or Denied

The insurance carrier may accept or deny the claim.

If accepted, you are entitled to medical benefits and lost wage payments.

If denied, you will have to wait for a Law Judge to issue a decision in your claim.



Dispute? Request Further Action

If there is any dispute over medical treatment or proper payments, a Request for Further Action form can be filed to schedule a hearing.



Judge's Determination

Once Maximum Medical Improvement is reached, a Judge may determine your permanent impairment.

You may be entitled to a Schedule Loss of Use award or payments for your Loss of Wage Earning Capacity.

A settlement may be negotiated in some instances to completely resolve your claim.
