






CONDITION NOT SEVERE

For each of the major body systems, consider one disorder that is considered so severe that it precludes the person from performing his or her normal activities of daily living.

Compassionate Allowances: Certain cases may qualify for disability as soon as the diagnosis is confirmed, such as acute leukemia, Lou Gehrig's disease (ALS), or pancreatic cancer.
